The Lancaster County 4-H Dress Code (see link above) applies except that jackets are waived and riders may show in any shirt with sleeves long enough to allow for a 4-H armband. Armbands will be available for sale on the grounds.

Your age as of January 1, 2010, determines your 4-H age. Ages 8-11 compete in the elementary division, 12-14 as juniors, and 15-18 as seniors. Walk-trot riders are age 8-11 showing for the first time in a discipline and may not show in other classes in that discipline requiring a lope/canter. Novice riders are age 12-18 and have just started riding and showing.

Wranglers members pay \$5 office fee per rider and \$3/class. Non-members pay \$6 office fee and \$4/class.

Champion and reserve awards in addition to 4-H ribbons will be provided by Salt Creek Wranglers.
